Plans for Summer Camps

The theme for Junior Camp is "Courage in Captivity", while Teenweek's theme is "Praise Him Again in 2010". Both sessions will have age appropriate lessons from the book of Daniel.

**Junior Camp lessons (June 1-4) for grades 4-6**

Tuesday: Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego's decision to not defile their bodies with the king's royal food and wine.

Wednesday: Faith in the face of fire. This is the story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego refusing to bow down to the 90-foot tall image of gold even though they were certain to be thrown into the fiery furnace.

Thursday: The story of King Belshazzar and the handwriting on the wall. This is a great reminder to honor God in all we do.

Friday: The last lesson will be Daniel in the lions' den. This story is inspiring for young and old alike. After all, Daniel was over eighty years old at the time, believe it or not.

**Teenweek's lessons (July 18-24) for grades 7-12**

Daniel 9 - Daniel's Prayer. This passage inspires us to take our prayer life seriously. There is perhaps no one in Old Testament history who had a better relationship with God than Daniel. Yet, he did not take God for granted. He walked humbly before God, confessing his sins.

Daniel 4 - God Rules in the Kingdoms of Men. This is about the very bizarre dream of King Nebuchadnezzar who learns a valuable lesson the hard way. He winds up eating grass with the cows because he gave himself all the credit for his power and the greatness of his kingdom. Nebuchadnezzar's power was restored after he looked up and gave God proper praise.

Daniel 2 - A fascinating prophecy which foretold the rise and fall of the four world empires, and the establishment of the church 600 years in advance. What a faith-builder!

Daniel 1 - Teens can learn a valuable lesson from this chapter. A teenage Daniel and his three friends showed remarkable faith in God. They chose to eat vegetables and water while in captivity instead of the king's royal food and wine. This resulted in a relationship with God that would carry them through many trials.

Daniel 3 - The heat is turned up on Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, but they still wouldn't dishonor God by bowing to an image of gold. Are we ever guilty of honoring created things above the Creator?
